## **Privacy Policy**

We respect your right to the privacy of your personal information. All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. This information will be used solely for the purpose of enabling the purchase of products by you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access. **We do not share customer details with any 3rd parties.** 

We collect personally identifiable information that you voluntarily provide to us when you request information, place an order or create an account.

We store Details of your visits to our site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblogs and other communication data.

We may also collect information that you provide by filling in forms on this websites. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our site, subscribing to our service, posting material or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our site.

Name, e-mail address, mailing address, telephone number, other optional demographic information are among the details that we may require from you.

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes.

We use information to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us. We also want to provide you with information, products or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you. The information you give us ensures that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer. We may also use information to notify you about changes to our service.

## **Cookie Policy**

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer, tablet or phone when you visit a website. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site.

Cookies are not computer programs and they cannot spread viruses. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. They cannot access other information stored on your computer.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies in your browser settings. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

If you continue to browse our sites without adjusting your browser settings you are agreeing to our use of the cookies.

First party cookies are set by the website you are visiting and they can only be read by that site.

Session cookies are stored only temporarily during a browsing session and are deleted from the users device when the browser is closed. if they are disabled then various functionalities on the site will not work as expected as these are strictly necessary to the functioning of the website.

Others Cookies remain on your device until they expire or you delete them from your cache. These are known as persistent cookies and enable us to remember things about you as a returning visitor.

Tracking Cookies help us gather and analyse non-specific visitor information such as new visitor numbers, shopping times, browser usage, and response to marketing activity.

We don't control the setting of third party cookies. From sites such as Facebook, Twitter, etc, you may be sent cookies. We suggest you check the third-party website for more information about their cookies and how to manage them.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
